Our products are affordable, hand crafted, made in the USA and shipping is included in the cost of each item. Located just 6 miles from Santa Cruz California, Peter and Kim have a dedicated sea glass studio. The studio affords Peter the ability to bring the creative designs to life, by drilling each water etched piece of sea glass. The proprietary drilling process was developed over time by Peter, to reclaim these beautiful jewels of the sea.

Sea Glass Essentials is presently working with an established Conch Shell Jewelry designer to distribute jewelry via British Virgin Islands, US Virgin Islands and the Caribbean. Sea Glass Essentials designs have been displayed as (Sea Glass Santa Cruz) and sold at the 2006 and 2007 North American Sea Glass Association Festival and also, featured and sold in such fine local establishments such as "Many Hands Gallery" located in both Capitola and Santa Cruz California locations.
